Subject: Sugar Mill-wise Minimum Indicative Export Quotas (MIEQ) for export in 2018-19 sugar season under tradable export script schemes - extension of time to export sugar.


Whereas, in exercise of powers conferred by clause 5 of the Sugar (Control) Order, 1966, mill-wise Minimum Indicative Export Quota (MIEQ) for sugar season 2018-19 have been allocated vide DFPD's order dated 28.9.2018.

2. Further, vide Order dated 11.11.2019, the sugar mills which had partially exported their MIEQ of 2018-19 sugar season till 30.09.2019, were allowed to export their remaining MIEQ of 2018-19 sugar season by 31.12.2019.

3. Further, vide Order dated 11.2.2020, the sugar mills which had partially exported their MIEQ of 2018-19 sugar season till 30.09.2019, were allowed to export their remaining MIEQ of 2018-19 sugar season by 15.2.2020.

4. Now, it has been decided by the Central Government to allow those sugar mills which had partially exported their MIEQ of 2018-19 sugar season till 30.09.2019, to export the balance quantity of their MIEQ of 2018-19 sugar season by 14.03.2020, over and above the Maximum Admissible Export Quantity (MAEQ) allocated for 2019-20 sugar season.
