2.0 To fill up the above vacancies, State Federations of Madhya Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, member cooperative sugar factories of Tamil Nadu and the members from the group comprising representatives of cooperative sugar factories of (Aska, Bargarh & Bijayananda (Odisha), Bhoramdev, Ambika & Danteshwari (Chhattisgarh), Sanjivani (Goa), Pondicherry (Puducherry), Anakapalle, Chittoor, Chodavaram, Etikoppaka, Kovur, Nizamabad, Thandava, Vijayrama & Venkateshwara (Andhra Pradesh), Surangi (Dadra Nagar Haveli), Nowgong (Assam), Chittur (Kerala), Keshoraipatan (Rajasthan) are requested to nominate their **one** representative respectively to the General Body of NFCSF in the format given at **Annexure-I**. The nomination of representative should be supported by a fresh resolution passed by the Board of Management of the member factory or Member State Federation or produce a certificate signed by the MD / President of the society as per **Annexure-II**. The nomination of the representative should be in accordance to the provisions of section 38(3) of the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002, which is reproduced in **Annexure-III** and it also gives sections 29, 41, 43, 44 & 45 of the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002 and numbers 6,7,11,18(b),19,20 and 23(i)(d) of the Bye-laws of NFCSF.

3.0 Further, we would like to invite your kind attention to section 28 of the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002, which states that "No member of a Multi-State Cooperative Society shall exercise the rights of a member, unless he has made the payment to the society in respect of membership, or has acquired such interest in the society, as may be specified in the bye-laws". Section 29(a) of the Act further states that "**No person shall be eligible for being a member of a Multi-State Cooperative Society if he has made any default in payment of any amount to be paid to the Multi-State Cooperative Society under the bye-laws of such society**". In view of these, it is requested to you to kindly clear all your dues to NFCSF as per list of dues at **Annexure-IV**. After clearance of all your dues, please obtain a No Dues Certificate from NFCSF, which is to be attached alongwith your Nomination Form.



Relevant Extracts from Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act, 2002

29. Disqualification for member of a Multi-State Cooperative Society – No person shall be eligible for being a member of a Multi-State Cooperative Society if -

- (a) his business is in conflict or competitive with the business of such Multi-State Cooperative Society; or
- (b) he used for two consecutive years the services below the minimum level specified in the Bye-laws; or
- (c) he has not attended three consecutive General Meetings of the Multi-State Cooperative Society and such absence has not been condoned by the members in the General Meeting; or
- (d) he has made any default in payment of any amount to be paid to the Multi-State Cooperative Society under the Bye-laws of such society.

41. Board of Directors – (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act and rules, there shall be a Board of Directors for every Multi-State Cooperative Society consisting of such number of members as specified in sub-section (3).

(2) The members of a Multi-State Cooperative Society, by a resolution in a General Meeting, shall elect Directors who shall be members of Board.

(3) The Board shall consist of such number of Directors as may be specified in the bye-laws:

Provided that the maximum number of Directors in no case shall exceed twenty-one:

Provided further that the Board may co-opt two Directors in addition to twenty-one Directors specified in the first proviso:

Provided also that the functional Directors in the national co-operative societies shall also be the members of the Board and such members shall be excluded for the purpose of counting the total number of Directors specified in the first proviso.

43. Disqualifications for being a member of Board - (1) No member of any Multi-State Cooperative Society or nominee of a member, society or a national co-operative society shall be eligible for being chosen as, or for being, a member of the Board of such Multi-State Co-operative Society or a national co-operative society or of any other co-operative society to which the Multi-State Co-operative Society is affiliated, if such member :-

- (a) has been adjudged by a competent court to be insolvent or of unsound mind;
- (b) is concerned or participates in the profits of any contract with the society;
- (c) has been convicted for an offence involving moral turpitude;
- (d) holds any office or place of profit under the society:

Provided that the Chief Executive or such full-time employee of the society as may be notified by the Central Government from time to time or a person elected by the employees of such society to represent them on the Board of such society shall be eligible for being chosen as, or for being, a member of such Board;

- (e) has been a member of the society for less than twelve months immediately preceding the date of such election or appointment;
- (f) has interest in any business of the kind carried on by the society of which he is a member;
- (g) has taken loan or goods on credit from the society of which he is a member, or is otherwise indebted to such society and after the receipt of a notice of default issued to him by such society, has defaulted -
 - (i) in repayment of such loan or debt or in payment of the price of the goods taken on credit, as the case may be, within the date fixed for such repayment or payment or where such date is extended, which in no case shall exceed six months, within the date so extended, or
 - (ii) when such loan or debt or the price of goods taken on credit is to be paid in instalments, in payment of any instalment, and the amount in default or any part thereof has remained unpaid on the expiry of six months from the date of such default:

Provided that a member of the Board who has ceased to hold office as such under this clause shall not be eligible, for a period of one year, from the date on which he ceased to hold office, for re-election as a member of the Board of the Multi-State Co-operative Society of which he was a member or for the election to the Board of any other Multi-State Co-operative Society;

- (h) is a person against whom any amount due under a decree, decision or order is pending recovery under this Act;
- (i) is retained or employed as a legal practitioner on behalf of or against the Multi-State Co-operative Society, or on behalf of or against any other Multi-State Co-operative Society which is a member of the former society.

Explanation – For the purposes of this clause, "legal practitioner" has the same meaning as in clause (i) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Advocates Act, 1961 (25 of 1961);

- (j) has been convicted for any offence under this Act;
- (k) is disqualified for being a member under section 29;
- (l) has been expelled as a member under section 30;
- (m) absents himself from three consecutive Board meetings and such absence has not been condoned to by the Board;
- (n) absents himself from three consecutive General Body Meetings and such absence has not been condoned by the members in the General Body.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for being elected as member of a Board of a Multi-State Co-operative Society for a period of five years if the Board of such Multi-State Co-operative Society fails -

- (a) to conduct elections of the Board under section 45; or
- (b) to call the Annual General Meeting under section 39; or
- (c) to prepare the financial statement and present the same in the Annual General Meeting.

44. Prohibition to hold office of Chairperson or President or Vice-Chairperson or Vice-President in certain cases - (1) No member of a Board shall be eligible to be elected as the Chairperson or President or Vice-Chairperson or Vice-President of a Multi-State Co-operative Society if such member is a Minister in the Central Government or a State Government.

2) No member of a Board shall be eligible to be elected as the Chairperson or President of a Multi-State Co-operative Society, after he has held the office as such during two consecutive terms, whether full or part:

Provided that a member who has ceased to hold the office of the Chairperson or President continuously for one full term shall again be eligible for election to the office as such.

Explanation - Where any member holding the office of the Chairperson or President at the commencement of this Act is again elected to that office after such commencement, he shall for the purpose of this section, be deemed to have held office for one term before such election.

Part

45. Elections of members of Board - (1) The conduct of elections to the Board of a Multi-State Co-operative Society shall be the responsibility of the existing Board.

(2) The election of members of Board shall be held by secret ballot in the manner as may be prescribed.

(3) The election of the members of the Board shall be held in the General Meeting of the members of the Multi-State Co-operative Society.

(4) The elected members of the Board shall, if the Bye-laws of such society permit, be eligible for re-election.

(5) The term of office of the elected members of the Board shall be such, not exceeding five years from the date of elections, as may be specified in the Bye-laws of a Multi-State Co-operative Society:

Provided that elected members shall continue to hold office till their successors are elected or nominated under the provisions of this Act or the rules or Bye-laws and assume charge of their office.

(6) Where the Board fails to conduct election of the members of Board, the Central Registrar shall hold the election within a period of ninety days from the date when such election became due.

(7) No person shall be eligible to be elected as a member of the Board of a Multi-State Co-operative Society unless he is a member of the General Body of that society.

(8) The expenses for holding election by the Central Registrar shall be borne by the Multi-State Co-operative Society.

(9) The Central Government may make rules generally to provide for or to regulate matters in respect of election of members of the Board.

Relevant extracts from the Bye-laws of NFCSF

Bye-law No. 6.i) Every cooperative sugar factory which is affiliated to the NFCSF shall pay an annual subscription at a rate pro-rata to production of sugar in the immediately preceding accounting year as may be determined by the Board of Directors of the NFCSF from time to time.

Bye-law No.6.ii) Every State and Zonal Federation affiliated to the NFCSF shall pay to the NFCSF an annual subscription at a rate as may be determined by the Board of Directors of NFCSF from time to time.

Bye-law No.7 Every member cooperative sugar factory which has not gone into production shall on affiliation, pay an annual subscription at a rate as may be determined by the Board of Directors of NFCSF from time to time.

Bye-law No.11.1) The General Body of the NFCSF shall consist of one nominee of each member State/Zonal Federations and member cooperative sugar factories.

2) The nomination to the General Body under Bye law No. 11 (1) shall be for a period of five years unless a nomination is withdrawn before the expiry of the term. The member can then nominate another nominee in the resultant vacancy for the remaining period of the term.

Bye-law No.18.b) A nominee or representative of a member of the General Body shall not be eligible to participate in the meetings of the General Body during the period of default of the member in payment of annual subscription or contribution in terms of Bye-law Nos.6 & 7.

Bye-law No.19.(1) The Board of Directors shall consist of members on the following basis :

i) One representative from each State and Zonal Federation having working cooperative sugar factories affiliated to it.

- ii) Representative from States having atleast 10 member working cooperative sugar factories affiliated to NFCSF to be elected on the following basis:

<u>No. of factories affiliated to NFCSF</u>	<u>Representation on the Board</u>
10-30	1 representative
31-50	2 representatives from two separate constituencies in a State
51-70	3 representatives from three separate constituencies in a State
71 & above	4 representatives from four separate constituencies in a State

- iii) One representative of a group comprising working cooperative sugar factories in States having no State Federation and having less than 10 sugar factories.
- iv) Two to be co-opted by the Board.
- v) Managing Director provided that he shall not vote in the election of office bearers.

Bye-law No.19.(2) All the members of the Board of Directors except the Managing Director shall hold office for a period of five years from the date of election. Members of the Board of Directors shall continue in office until another Board is constituted.

Bye-law No.19.(3) The Board may invite not more than two persons to attend its meetings.

Bye-law No.20 The members of the Board of Directors shall elect from amongst Directors constituted under Bye-law No.19(1) (i) and (ii) a President and a Vice-President. The term of office of the President and the Vice-President shall be co-terminus with the term for which the Board has been constituted. In case of any vacancy arising within this period, the Board may fill up the vacancy through re-election for the unexpired term of the Board provided the President and the Vice-President shall be elected only from amongst representatives specified in Bye-law No. 19(i) and (ii).

Bye-law No.23(i)(d) A member of the Board of Directors shall cease to hold office if he ceases to represent the affiliated member in the General Body of the NFCSF.
